This sample is only part of Scroll 11. Case 1 illustrates how we can use Yijing Divination to find out the Feng Shui of a house without seeing the house. A lot of professional diviners in Hong Kong, Taiwan and Mainland China are using this method. The clients are just amazed at the ability to tell so much of the house without seeing it. Some clients even suspect that the diviner's spirit has left his body to pay the house a brief visit.



Case 1

Professional Yijing Divination for Mr. Tong

Date: 16 th Jul, 1998 **Wu Yin year Ji Wei month Jia Zi day**

Background: Mr. Tong wanted to buy a house at XXX Crescent Vancouver. He wanted to know whether the house had good Feng Shui.

Hexagram: Mountain on Earth (Bo), Line 3 and Line 5 moving to Wind on Mountain (Jian)

Void: Xu, Hai **Month Break:** Chou **Gua Shen:** Xu

1. Subject Zi represents Mr. Tong, Object Si represents the house. Subject controls Object and is auspicious.

2. Shen represents the door while Hai represents the road/pathway. Shen is Brothers which indicates that money leaks through the door. Hai is Offspring which indicates that the road brings happiness to the house.

3. Shen generates the moving Subject Zi. This indicates that Mr. Tong will spend money entertaining his friends in the house. This brings him happiness and is of course costly.

4. Hai being void and absent means that a new pathway has to be built from the Hai direction to the door. The door should also be changed to the east to receive wealth.

5. Spirit of Focus Xu is void. It is also the gua shen. Mr. Tong has a lot of doubt about the house and he will not be able to make up his mind until Jia Xu day.

6. Wife/Wealth Mao moves and changes to control back. In order to live comfortably, a lot of money has to be spend on renovation.

7. Line 6 Yin wood represents the water mouth. The water mouth brings wealth to the house. Therefore the door must be located and pathway be designed to receive the water from the water mouth.

8. The Object Si fire is Officer/Ghost as well as the Bird. This indicates lawsuit. Care must be taken in signing the sales and purchase agreement. A good lawyer is needed.

Note: I did not give recommendation whether to buy the property or not. I just laid down the facts to help Mr. Tong make his decision. I also recommended what to do should he decided to buy the property.
